Weather Normalization Adjustment

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PUC) has approved the continuation of Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania's Weather Normalization Adjustment (WNA). The WNA will be effective January 1, 2026, for all residential customers. The WNA is a method of billing based on "normal" weather, utilizing 10-year average temperature information provided by the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) to define normal weather and the Degree Days Deficiencies method to determine heating requirements. This recognized standard enables Columbia Gas to remove some of the effects of abnormal weather on the delivery portion of customers' bills during the heating season (November through April). Phase II Energy Efficiency Rider

The PUC has approved Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania's Three-Year Energy Efficiency (EE) Plan – Phase II. The program is designed to help the Company's eligible residential and commercial customers reduce their energy consumption, improve efficiency, and conserve resources. The initial Phase II EE rider rate per therm, effective January 1, 2026, is \$0.00634 for eligible residential customers and \$0.00343 for eligible commercial customers. The program will offer natural gas-saving opportunities through equipment rebates and installation of energy-efficiency equipment.
